## SCHOOL UNIFORM:

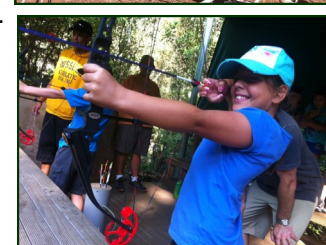
