SCHOOL UNIFORM:



We thank you for your co-operation in ensuring our students are wearing the correct school uniform. Just a reminder, that it is important that our school uniform is worn correctly. This includes no PE shirts to be worn to school, or home in the afternoons. Year 7/8 children only, to wear their PE tops at school (*not to be worn to and from school*), and on the days that they have sport. Black shoes (with no other colour), worn with white, black or navy ankle socks, and/or black sandals. Black running shoes or sandals with black laces. We are holding a letter to all parents, from Number 1 Shoes (if you choose to), offering a 10% discount on MVS shoes, and a wide selection is being offered. If you would like a copy of this letter, please see Lee Alesich in the Uniform Shop. The hours are Monday/Tuesday/Wednesdays 8.30am – 9.00am and Tuesday afternoon 2.45pm – 3.30pm. You are free to purchase your child's shoes wherever you wish, but they must be black (including shoelaces). *By the start of Term 2, we hope that every child is wearing the correct footwear.* Once again, thank you for your co-operation.
