Dear Parents and Caregivers,

IMPORTANT NOTICE FROM NZ TRANSPORT AGENCY: On 1st November 2013 the child restraint laws will be changing. The mandatory use of child restraints in vehicles will be extended by two years, with all children required to be correctly secured in an approved restraint until their 7th birthday (this includes booster seats).
