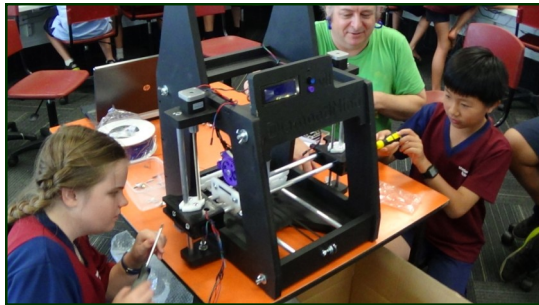
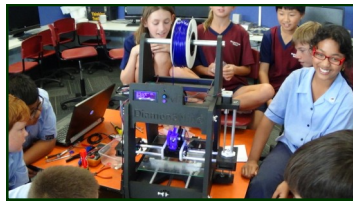

Welcome back to Term 2 at Marina View School. A special welcome to the children and families who are new to the Marina View School community.

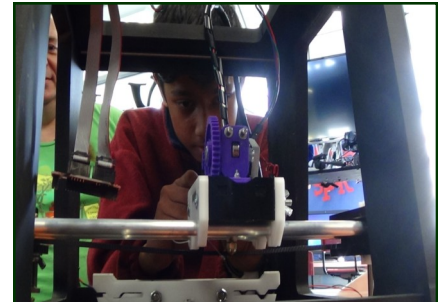

CONGRATULATIONS TO MVS EX PUPILS:

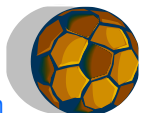
