First the school teacher lead Room 11 and the parent helpers to the old school. It was cold inside, and very quiet. The teacher told Room 11 that children in the olden days were seen but never heard, and if they were heard they would be very naughty. Everything was wooden and hard, most teachers were very strict in the olden days. The children also did arithmetic with 12 times tables. Children had to know them backwards and forwards so they were good at counting pennies (coins). Room 11 had little slate boards, a slate pen and a bit of material for rubbing out. The children had to write "Every Day had its Duties" in olden day handwriting.
