Welcome back to our final Term for 2010.

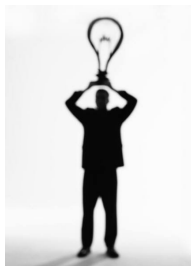
Thank you to all who supported our valuable visit to the Awataha Marae and our colourful International Day. Meeting all those wonderful Grandparents was very special.
