SCHOOL REMINDERS

Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccine National Immunisation Programme—will be offered through a two year school based programme for girls in Yrs 8, 12 and 13 in 2009 and Yrs 8, 10, 11 and 12 in 2010. Girls who are eligible for the vaccine will receive information and a consent form. With signed consent, they will be able to receive the immunisation at school. Information about the HPV immunisation programme is available on the Ministry of Health website www.moh.govt.nz/immunisation or Ph 0800-466-863—Immunisation Advisory Centre. A letter will come home with eligible children reminding you of dates and times for talks and vaccinations. These will be **Wed 11 Mar:** HPV talks and consent forms for Yr 8 girls; HPV and Booster Vaccinations Yr7 and Yr8 **Wed 8 Apr**—Booster Talks and consent forms Yr7 boys and girls; **Thu 30 Apr**—

HPV and Booster vaccinations for Yr7 and 8: **Thu 11 Jun**—HPV2 vaccination Yr 8 girls; **Fri 11 Sep** HPV3 vaccination Yr 8 girls.

There will be a **Netball Notice** going out on 27 February requesting Netball Coaches. Our teams will be limited, depending on response. Please email kcowsill@marinav.school.nz.
